

### about project

Environment and W\_UP project in Cambodia is defined as a mixture of raising awareness campaign and change-making actions organised by CYA in cooperation with project partners and Ministry of Environment, Cambodia.

Environment & W\_Up project will offer quality- learning experiences to international participants; raising awareness at international and local level on waste issues; financially supporting non-profit organisations and local communities through social entrepreneurship; working with local community to have a better management of their waste.

Throughout the project, International and national participants will work together with local people and other stakeholders to create a better community environment, planting mangroves, and join Waste Upcycling workshop to produce the products from the waste.

We believe that the environmental activities will raise awareness for the local people and participants on different issues and find its solution while the workshop will foster active participation of the local community and will contribute to help local people look for innovative solutions on waste management in their own social contexts.







# Specific objectives

Environment and waste upcycling special workcamp or project in Cambodia is organized to preserve, protect, and raised awareness on environmental issues, waste issues, and to foster entrepreneurial through up-cycling products.

- 1. 2023 mangrove seeds will be planted at TFC protected area in Kampot Province to celebrate World Environment Day 2023.
- 2. At least 40 volunteers and local people will be trained on making eco bin and furniture from used car tyre
- 3. At the end of the W\_Up project, 20 eco bins and 5 sets of upcycling tables and seats will be will be produced.
- 4. A cleaning campaign will be organized to clean at least 5 houses of local people and paint on each house wall about environment and waste upcycling.

## project activities

To achieve our objectives above, CYA and Ministry of Environment Cambodia are going to organize different activities as follow:



# mangrove planting

All participants of the project will gather at Trapaing Sangke Fishing community (TFC) to celebrate World Environment Day 2023 by planting 2023 mangrove seeds in community protected area









# **Waste Upcycling Workshop**

Local people and participants are going to participate in the workshop to learn about making upcycling products from used car tyre and then they will be ask to work as team to make eco-bins, furniture, and other stuffs









# **Community Cleaning Campaign**

We will select local people houses to be sample of beautiful house where our participants will work together with house's owner to clean it up and place the eco-bin with separate trash sign on it and train them how they can manage their trash separately. More importantly part of the house wall will be painted on topic related to environment and upcycling.

#### **Food & Accommodation**

Participants will stay at Bungalow for TFC project site and volunteers's house at Center for Sustainable Development (CSD). Room will be separated for men and women with share bathrooms. And food will be provided 3 meals per days in simple Cambodian dishes.









#### Leisure Activities

There are several options for leisure activities as the hosting project are nearby many tourist attractions such as Bokor national park, Kep beach, Rabit island, Peter plantation, and more...
